Position(s) Overview:

The right individual in the Intake position will be given the opportunity to help families in Wayne County by screening incoming referrals regarding child abuse or neglect, investigating allegations and providing short-term counseling, referring to other agency departments or initiating custody proceedings.

In the Ongoing position you'll have the opportunity to provide direct services to families on a more long term basis by completing risk assessments, proving counseling, making referrals, and creating and monitoring case plans.

Minimum Qualifications:

Bachelor's degree in Social Work or a related field required. LSW/LISW or eligibility for licensure by the State of Ohio preferred. This position is required to maintain residency within a one-hour response time to all points in Wayne County while on-call. Must have a valid Ohio driver's license with an acceptable driving record in accordance with agency policy. Must own, lease, or have immediate access to safe and reliable personal transportation to use for work related responsibilities, including transporting children and adults, when an agency vehicle is not available. Must maintain minimum insurance, per agency policy, on said transportation.
